The Fourth Motor Insurance Directive is designed to improve the claims process for EU citizens who are involved in motor accidents in other EU member countries. The principle requirement is that a claimant should be able to identify the relevant insurer from the Vehicle Registration Mark. This may also help to combat uninsured driving. In the UK this legislation requirement is met by the 'Motor Insurance Database' (MID) which has been designed to provide a record of all insured motor vehicles registered for use on the road.

To comply with legislation we require any additions or vehicle alterations to be notified immediately. Various notification methods are available. Please indicate your preferred method from the choices below.
