# Safety of Road Tankers carrying Hazardous Contents

From the 1st July 2006, The Carriage of Dangerous Goods Regulations (CDG) and the European ADR require road and rail tanker operators to have examinations and testing carried out by an Approved Inspection Body.

## Legal Requirements and Duties

For tanks constructed on or before the 9th May 2004 the CDG Regulations shall apply, whilst tanks built on or after the 10th May 2004 will need to comply with the European ADR.

## Initial Inspection and Testing

All tanks are required to have an Initial Certificate of Inspection which will record the tank details and stipulate the type of products that can be safely transported in the tank.

## Periodic Examinations and Testing

All tanks shall be periodically inspected by an Approved Inspection Body in accordance with a Written Scheme of Examination or ADR.

## Repairs and Modifications

A tank must be inspected and tested by an Approved Inspection Body following any major repairs or modifications. The Initial Certificate may also need to be reviewed and amended.

## What is a hazardous substance?

Examples of hazardous substances include; petrol, liquefied petroleum gas (LPG), paints, varnishes, waste products, chemicals and other gases.

## Who is affected by these Regulations?

Operators and owners of road or rail tankers carrying hazardous substances

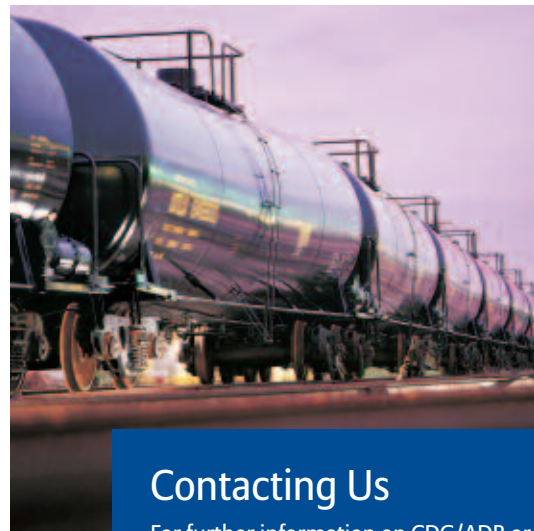
